Chebrolu Engineering College and Recycle shall hereinafter be referred to individually as a "**Party**" and collectively as the "**Parties**", as the case may be. **Whereas, recycle** is sustainability, digital technology service provider, with solutions to promote & facilitate recycling activities and also wants to engage with a sustainability partner.

WHEREAS "Chebrolu Engineering College" wishes to on-board with **Recycle** its sustainability solution partner to enable the responsible disposal of dry recyclables during the period 11th August 2019 to 10th August 2022.

NOW Therefore, in consideration of the aforesaid and the mutual promises between the Parties under this Agreement, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

I. Now This MOU Witnessed as Under:

2. Scope:

- Rates for recyclables will be displayed time to time on Recycle.
- **Chebrolu Engineering College** will raise invoices of the value to be received against the disposal of recyclable.
- The sustainability certificate for responsible disposal through the Recycle will be provided and the same can be accessed on Recycle dashboard.
- **Chebrolu Engineering College** is required to provide necessary entry and exit permissions included, but not restricted to gate-pass, other access formalities to use its space for loading of recyclable and man power movement during the time of pickup.

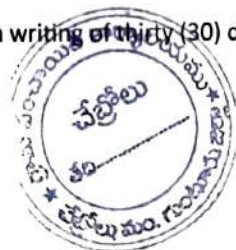
4. Termination:

This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Except as provided otherwise, the courts in Guntur shall have exclusive Jurisdiction over any matter arising out of this Agreement.


8. Survival of Terms: The class on "indemnity" "Dispute Resolution", "Governing Law and Jurisdiction" will survive the termination of this Agreement.

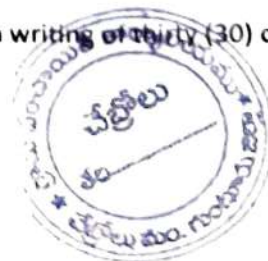
